1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is Monday, May 4, 2020 (no exceptions).
2. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements.
3. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
4. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will be returned to you. You may also download a copy of the application online at <http://www.coronanorcorepublicanwomen.com>
5. Scholarship recipients will be notified by email in November.

NOTE: Scholarship winner MUST attend our May 26th meeting to receive funds. The selected applicant is required to read their essay to our members. You may invite your family & friends. There is no cost to attend our meeting. Please RSVP to cnrwf@yahoo.com to reserve seating.

Purpose: To award scholarships to one (2) deserving high school graduating senior who attends school in the cities of Corona or Norco, intending to pursue post-high school course of study at either college/university or other post-secondary educational institution. Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited post-secondary institution.

NOTE: This process is non-partisan, and open to ALL seniors regardless of their political views.

Award Components: Two (2) one-time, \$500 scholarship awarded to two (2) students selected by the Corona Norco Republican Women Scholarship Committee.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a student in the cities of Corona or Norco, California.
2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
3. All essays should meet standard academic qualifications in grammar, punctuation, and spelling. (The CNRWF Scholarship Committee reserves the right to disqualify any essay not meeting such standards which could result in no scholarships being issued.)

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly).
2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation of career goals and biographical (background) information.
3. Personal Essay (1,000 words or less). In your essay, please answer the question on the enclosed essay form.

Deadline for the application is **Monday, May 4, 2020**. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
